New! Social and Emotional Development—Why We Do What We Do This workshop is designed to help childcare providers understand the "why" behind best practices. Participants will complete reading assignments, observations, and answer questions relating to their learning. The training includes a 158-page text book. 10 training hours.

Good for Children—Developmentally Appropriate Practices — This workshop is designed to familiarize providers of children 3 - 5 years with the phrase "Developmentally Appropriate Practices," explain the theory behind it, and how providers can integrate this into their programs. Includes a 98-page text book.

Positive Guidance for Childcare Providers — Learn how the essentials of quality care and the power of encouragement can help encourage positive behaviors in your program. Includes 219-page resource book.

The Who, What, and Why of Dramatic Play — Increase the options you provide in the area of dramatic play while gaining a greater understanding of the developmental importance of this element in the early childhood setting.

Using Snack Time for Nutrition Education — Quality nutrition education is essential! This course provides early childhood educators with important nutritional information regarding young children. It further provides ideas on how to optimize the opportunity of sharing information with families in your program.
